Guidance

- Up to four forms per site depending on which areas are available:
 1. Operating theatres (theatre area in which the majority of RSIs performed, does NOT include obstetric theatres)
 2. Obstetric theatres (dedicated obstetric theatre area where the majority of RSIs are performed)
 3. Critical care (ICU area in which the majority of RSIs are performed)
 4. Emergency department (ED resuscitation area in which the majority of RSIs are performed)
- For each clinical area, **please survey the main high-acuity location where RSI is performed most frequently**, especially if there are split clinical areas (e.g. multiple theatre complexes, separate obstetric theatres, remote anaesthetic locations, multiple critical care areas, multiple ED areas) and please report the **typical provision of resources for that area**.
- Please liaise with your other specialty Site Leads to decide who will complete this survey for each area.
- The survey will take between 20-30 minutes to complete.
